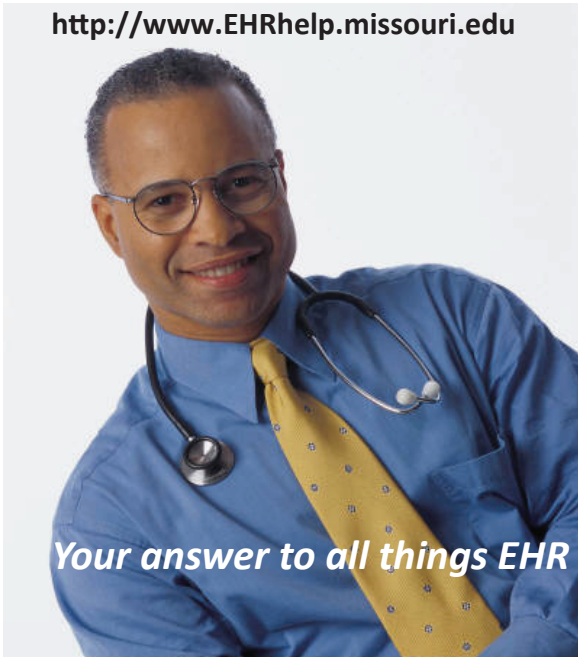

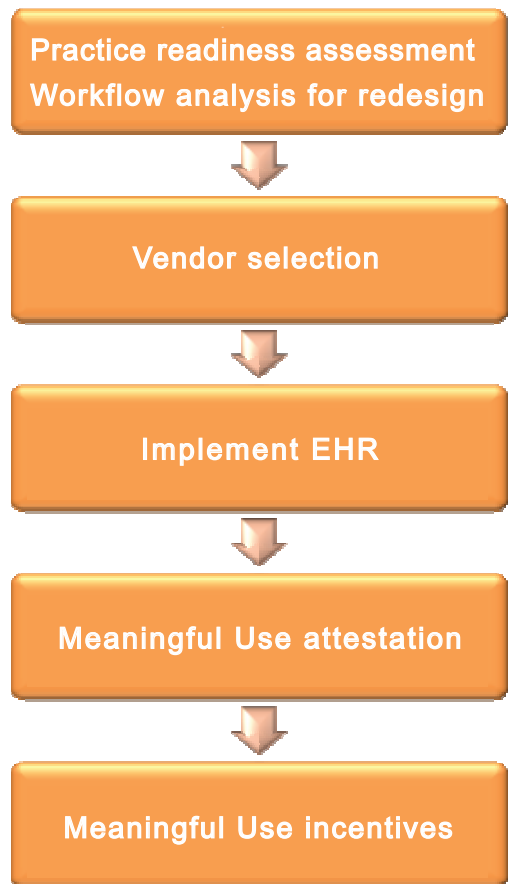

Earn EHR Incentives

New incentive programs are now available to eligible providers who become meaningful users of EHRs. Providers can earn up to \$44,000 in Medicare or up to \$63,750 in Medicaid incentives. Additional incentives are also available for hospitals.

Group EHR pricing

The MO HIT Assistance Center offers group pricing on select EHRs.
